#### Introduction

Maynooth University's John & Pat Hume Doctoral Awards are offered via a competitive scholarship programme that supports suitably qualified students intending to undertake a doctoral programme at the University. Evaluation criteria include the applicant's academic record and the quality of research proposal submitted for the competition and alignment to the MU research strengths, priority areas and beacons.

References form a crucial part of assessing the applications. Each MU supervisor must write a reference for the applicant they plan to supervise on the PhD programme.

#### **The reference must be signed by the Supervisor and Head of Department.**

Applications that are not supported by a supervisor reference by the specified deadline will be deemed ineligible and excluded from the competition. It is therefore very important that the applicant allows sufficient time to request the reference and upload the signed reference provided to their Hume scholarship application before the deadline.

Only supervisors who have submitted an Expression of Interest prior to the deadline can supervise a Hume applicant for the 2025-2026 awards programme. Students can only submit an application to the research areas collated from the Expressions of Interest.

**Supervisors must be permanent members of academic staff at the grade of assistant lecturer or above or contract lecturers on a contract of three years or more who have received approval from their head of department that they may act as supervisors (see GRA form GSF12).**
